



Add Google+ Authorship to Your Website Search Result

1. Go to your Google+ Page, copy the URL, and paste this tag into the header of your website.

```
<link rel="author" href="your google + url" />
```

Example: This is mine...

```
<link rel="author" href="https://plus.google.com/u/0/116330641961287637835/posts" />
```

2. Select Profile on the left hand column. Choose the About tab. Click Edit Profile in the top right corner. Scroll down to "Contributor to:" Click Add custom link. Add the Title (label) and the URL to your website.
3. Go to: <http://www.google.com/webmasters/tools/richsnippets#>. Type in your URL. You should see something like this:
